*Entry Level Careers: Require a high school diploma, vocational training and/or job training:*

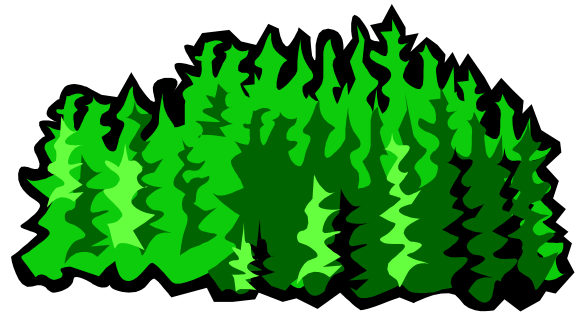
- \* Forest & Conservation Worker
